Dear Brothers & Sisters:

We are writing today to bring you greetings and share some about a recent missions trip that Tammy, Lori McCaw, and Jessica Albin were a part of in November 2023.

They went 2 days earlier so they could visit Ababaw & Selah. Ababaw & Selah worked with Dr. Henok for many years and visited us in Claremore last September. Ababaw works for a US based ministry that he oversees educating those that missed 1st, 2nd, and 3rd grade in Ethiopia public school because of war and unrest. They provide three years of training in one year, so the student qualifies to return to public school for 4th grade.

Tammy, Lori, & Jessica returned from their Medical/Dental Mission trip with Hand of Hope in November 2023 with great news of over 4,400 patients that was seen in the 4 ½ days of clinics in rural Ethiopia. The Hand of Hope team from the US, Canada, UK, and Austria made up by some 40+ volunteers, came along side some 50+ Ethiopia volunteers.

Our people also had a privilege to visit a new Crisis Aid location called "Mercy Chapel" in Aleta Ethiopia. This location has a home for rescued girls with vocation training. Once they rescue the girls from trafficking and the red light district, they house and provide vocational training so upon graduation the girls have a trade to support their family. This new location had the first graduating class of 74 girls in January 2023.

While the team was visiting Mercy Chapel, the sewing machines came to a stop when the electricity went off, which happens often. Electric outages extends the number of days it will take to train the girls past the normal 9 months.

Tammy returned home from Ethiopia with a desire to see a generator for Mercy Chapel so they are able to continue and not be interrupted with electric outages. We are reaching out to share with others if they are able to join us in helping meet this ultimate goal of \$18,000, of which \$9,000 is pledged.

The civil engineer assess the project and has recommended a generator/inverter. Installing a hybrid (solar/battery) inverter:

- Running cost is much lower since it can use solar/battery energy and frequent purchases of fuel, oil and lubricant will not be needed.
- It is lighter, smaller, and doesn't take up as much space.

- Easy maintenance, low need for repairs.
- Less noise, fewer greenhouse emissions, environmentally friendly.
- Safe for sensitive electronics (laptops) with no power fluctuation.
