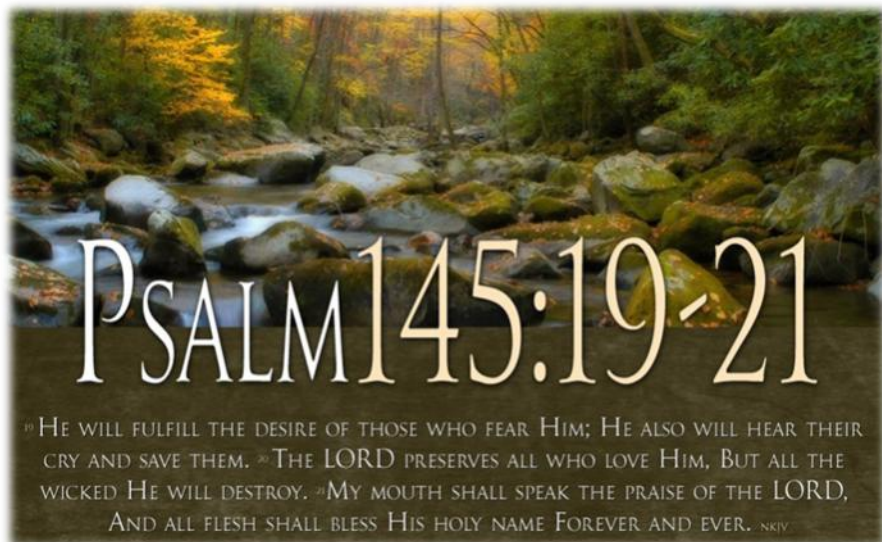

A CREATIVE GOD - BILLY GRAHAM DEVOTION

For we know not what we should pray for as we ought; but the Spirit himself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. —Romans 8:26

John Knox, with an all-consuming soul-concern for his country, prayed, “Give me Scotland, or I die!” His earnest travail was rewarded with a spiritual rebirth in his land. This is what is termed “praying in the Spirit.” It is the manifestation of a deep spiritual concern for others, and it is instilled by the Spirit of God. This kind of prayer can leap over oceans, speed across burning deserts, spring over mountains, bound through jungles, and carry the healing, helping power of the Gospel to the object of prayer.



That “the Spirit Himself makes intercession” indicates that it is actually God pleading, praying, and mourning through us. Thus we become co-laborers with God, actual partners with Him; our lives are lifted from the low plane of selfishness to the high plane of creativeness with God. John Knox travailed, and the Church in Scotland broke into new life.

Prayer: My heart's cry is heard—thank You, Lord Jesus!

before you have suffered; if you are suffering without succeeding, it is that others after you may succeed.”

Happy are they that mourn. They can be happy because they know that their pain, their distress, and their privation are the travail of a new creation, the birth pangs of a better world. They can be happy if they are aware that the Master Artist, God, is employing both light and shadow to produce a masterpiece worthy of divine artistry.

They can also glory in their infirmities, smile through their tears, and sing in the midst of their sorrow, because they realize that in God’s economy, “If we suffer, we shall also reign with Him.”

PERSECUTED PASTOR BEATEN, IMPRISONED BEFORE MIRACLE

A pastor from India was arrested under the anti-conversion law of his state. He was put in prison because he had been warned and he kept on evangelizing. He kept on pastoring a church and, for some reason, they wanted to make an example of him. So the first seven days that he was in prison, he was beaten repeatedly. They hung him upside down and two guards would beat him literally until they were too tired to continue. Despite the horrific beating, he said the pastor didn’t feel the pain — something he believes is miraculous.

He’s beaten the first seven days of his imprisonment, and then the warden comes to him and says, “Hey, you know, I’m an equal opportunity warden, and, in my prison, we celebrate all the different religious festivals.”

With Good Friday upon them, the warden decided to let the pastor celebrate and actually asked if he would want to share with other prisoners about the meaning of the day and why Christians celebrate it. The pastor said, “Yes, I will do that.” He stood up and had the opportunity to share.”

“The fact that this warden who had ordered him to be beaten is now giving him that opportunity — yeah, only God could work that out,” he said. “God changed the warden’s heart, and literally he assigned two other prisoners to take care of that pastor, to make sure he had food, to do his laundry for him. And he gave the pastor access to the entire prison to go around and talk to other prisoners.”

And that’s not all. The pastor also prayed for the warden’s son, who ultimately recovered from an illness in a “mind-blowing, amazing” way, with miracles evident throughout the story.

MULTIPLE PEOPLE CLAIM THEY SAW JESUS AT THE SAME EVENT

In a series of extraordinary testimonies, six attendees from Deep Believer’s recent Night With the King gathering claim they witnessed visible appearances of Jesus Christ during the event.

In a video with Jennifer Bagnaschi from Deep Believer, Norma, who was praying in the back of the church with Juliana, says she saw Jesus kneeling beside them. “He was just in white...in our sitting posture next to Juliana near her shoulder,” she recounted. Eda, who observed them from the end of the bench, reported stating that it was “...not just the two of them. I saw three. It was a silhouette white [with them].”

Worship leader Sandielyn says that as she sang, she saw Jesus in the church, “His robe beaming white,” which left her trembling. Even Bagnaschi later shared that she also saw Him walk past her aisle, “smiling.”

Brandon also described his experience, noting, “...I saw the Lord in His face, and He was breathing upon us... It was a reminder for me to know the time that we’re in. We are preparing for His coming.”
