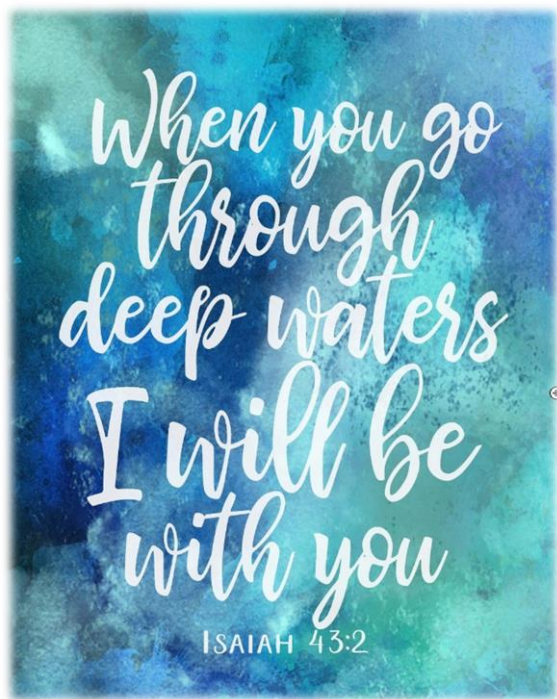

Chapter 32 – The Inside Scoop

THE MYSTERY OF HIS LOVE - BILLY GRAHAM DEVOTION

I have loved thee with an everlasting love . . . - Jeremiah 31:3

No human experience can fully illustrate the imputed righteousness of God, as conceived by His infinite love. It is a mystery-incomprehensible and inexplicable. Like the mystery of the sun’s heat and light, we cannot measure it or explain it, and yet we could not live without it. Writing of the mystery of completed righteousness, Paul said, “We speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom, which God ordained before the world unto our glory. . . . But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love Him” (1 Corinthians 2:7, 9). What God has wrought in us is wonderful. But His work has just begun. He has a wonderful, exciting, thrilling future for all of His believing children.

True Love Puts Others First

GOD BELIEVES IN YOU - JENTEZEN FRANKLIN

Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see. This is what the ancients were commended for.” Hebrews 11:1-2

Never let anyone else’s opinion become your reality. The Bible is full of doubters who tried to stop the momentum of God-given dreams. As you walk in God’s path toward His dream for your life, you will always experience naysayers.

Ten people in the Old Testament caused three million people to wander in the wilderness for 40 years. The Israelites let ten people’s opinions become the reality

for millions. How many people would it take to talk you out of what God has called you to do? That generation of Israelites missed out on the promised land because they believed in men rather than God.

Noah had a goal to build an ark. He was ridiculed by everyone who saw what he was doing, but the Bible says several times, “Noah did all that the Lord commanded him.” He obeyed God one day at a time, one task at a time until the vision was fulfilled.

Keep doing all that God leads you to do. Don’t let the voices of people stop you. They may even mean well, but they are not the ones who have been entrusted with the task.

King Saul also tried to force his negative opinion on David when David told him about the great task that God was calling him to do. He said, “You are not able to go against this Philistine and fight him; you are only a young man, and he has been a warrior from his youth.” But David decided that he wasn’t going to let one man’s opinion become his reality. He was convinced he could trust God to help him see the victory. David had a vision of how the fight would go and even told the giant exactly how he would be defeated! God believed in David, God believed in Noah, and God believed in you!

NO BLESSING IN PRETENDING - JOEL OSTEEN

The goal of this command is love, which comes from a pure heart and a good conscience and a sincere faith. Timothy 1:5, NIV

It's easy to go through life wearing masks, acting one way for our boss, one way for our friends, and another way for our spouse. Because we're not secure in who we are, we feel a need to impress, to prove something to people, so we pretend and hide behind personal masks. Oftentimes it's the mask of pride. I don't have any issues. I don't need any help. But God will not bless who you pretend to be. God blesses people who are real, people who are honest enough to say, God, I have this bad habit. I'm struggling with my temper. I need Your help, so I'm taking off the mask. When you're honest, you open the door for God to come in and change things. The apostle Paul said that love flows from a pure heart, a good conscience, and a sincere faith. It's time to take off that mask and be honest. When you get down to the real you, that's when God can turn things around.

Prayer: Father, thank You that I don't have to hide my weaknesses or mask my shortcomings. Search my heart and show me where my motives are wrong and where I'm pretending. I humbly admit that I don't have it all together, and I'm glad You're still working on me. In Jesus Name, Amen.

IN HIS IMAGE - BILLY GRAHAM DEVOTION

Create in me a new, clean heart, O God, filled with clean thoughts and right desires. - Psalm 51:10 (TLB)

You were created in the image and likeness of God. You were made for God’s fellowship, and your heart can never be satisfied without His communion. Just as iron is attracted to a magnet, the soul in its state of hunger is drawn to God. Though you, like thousands of others, may feel in the state of sin that the world is more alluring and more to your liking, some day-perhaps even now as you read these words-you will acknowledge that there is something deep down inside you which cannot be satisfied by the alloy of earth. Then with David, the Psalmist who had sampled the delicacies of sin and had found them unsatisfying, you will say,

“Oh God, thou art my God; early will I seek thee: my soul thirsteth for thee, my flesh longeth for thee in a dry and thirsty land, where no water is.”
Prayer: How I long for You, God, yet so often my heart is drawn away from Your leading. Like David, I desire a clean heart.

EXPECTATION IS THE
BREEDING GROUND FOR MIRACLES

1,600 DECISIONS FOR JESUS AT UNIVERSITY OF CENTRAL FLORIDA

UniteUS campus outreach ministry reports 1,600 students made decisions to "go all in with Jesus... revival is not slowing down!"
Over 5,000 students gathered to lift the name of Jesus. Hundreds of students were baptized and many who identified as Atheist now identify as Christian. What a night! What a God!
UniteUS has held two dozen Christian revival events on college campuses since the movement started three years ago. It all kicked off after the Asbury Awakening of February 2023 signaled a fresh move of the Spirit of God among American students.
The revival ministry has reached out at campuses such as FSU, Alabama, Georgia, Cincinnati, Grand Canyon, Tennessee, Oklahoma, and Purdue. Last fall, the Holy Spirit moved in the hearts of thousands of college students who met in September at the University of South Florida in Tampa. UniteUS reported that more than 1,000 chose Christ as Lord at that event, and a former Satan worshipper was among those who got baptized.
Then in November, hundreds accepted Christ as 6,000 gathered to worship Jesus at NC State, and hundreds more "fully surrendered their lives to Jesus" at Clemson University.
The ministry has even branched out to reach high school students, and 1,000 of them surrendered their hearts to Jesus at UniteUS Nashville in December.
