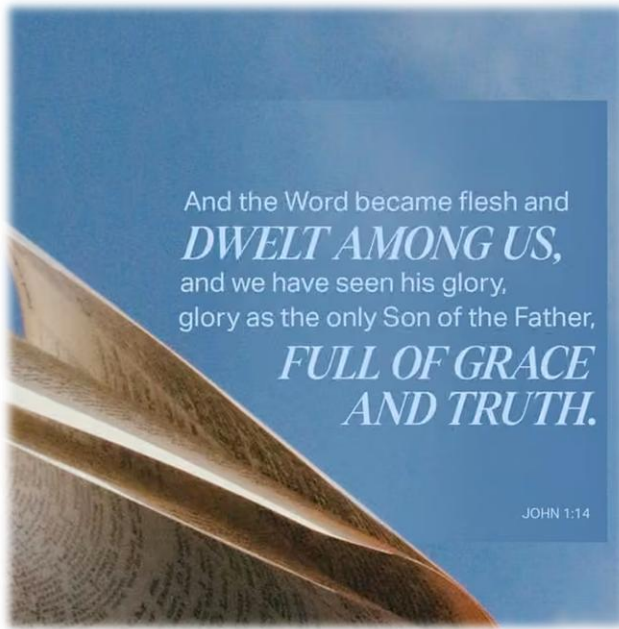

PRAY FOR THOSE IN RECENT VARIOUS NATURAL DISASTERS

Samaritan's Purse airlifted 100,000 pounds of relief to Colombia to assist families after a powerful earthquake that struck in the western part of the country, killing hundreds of people. The magnitude 7.4 temblor destroyed at least 1,600 homes and damaged thousands more. Many grieving families have lost their homes and people are living in makeshift shelters as rescue teams continue searching through the rubble for survivors. Their 767 aircraft departed the Samaritan's Purse Airlift Response Center in Greensboro, North Carolina, August 13 loaded with shelter supplies, solar lights, and hygiene kits.

"All of us were shocked to see the news and videos of the powerful earthquake in Colombia," said Samaritan's Purse President Franklin Graham. "Samaritan's Purse has worked in Colombia for many years and has three field offices in different areas there. I encourage you to pray for the people of this country. Many have died. People are sleeping on the streets in fear because of the strong aftershocks."

Residents in Bogota, roughly 150 miles east of the epicenter, could feel the effects as downtown buildings swayed. It is the strongest earthquake centered in Colombia in nearly five decades.

The destruction stretched across western Colombia, hitting the coffee-growing region especially hard. This area includes the cities of Pereira and Manizales. Cali, Colombia's third-largest city, and Quibdo, the capital of Choco, also sustained significant damage. Rescue crews continue to search for survivors beneath collapsed buildings.

Damaged roads, communications outages, and difficult terrain have complicated efforts to reach communities in remote parts of Choco, a region of rugged mountains, dense rainforest, and river valleys.

Please pray as we respond. Ask God to guide emergency responders and protect the many survivors who are suffering. Pray also that He would comfort grieving families and that they would experience the hope of His presence in their lives.

STATE DEPARTMENT TURNS TO FAITH-BASED GROUPS

The U.S. State Department has announced a historic partnership pledging nearly \$2 billion to faith-based organizations for global health and humanitarian aid. Under the "America First Global Health Strategy," groups like World Vision, Compassion International, and **Samaritan's Purse** will receive up to \$850 million over five years. Another \$1.4 billion will support some 2,500 faith-based hospitals and clinics, while also training and paying frontline community health workers.

The assistance follows recent massive cuts to USAID and comes as the Trump administration reshapes how the United States delivers foreign aid. That is just one of a growing list of challenges facing the State Department, from Iran and Gaza to visa security here at home.

Oftentimes, it's expertise. It's making sure that money, when it's spent, actually goes to the people that need it. It's trusted partners that have a track record of delivering that assistance in a way that is effective.

In Cuba, the U.S. has committed up to \$100 million in humanitarian assistance. The goal is to get that aid to the Cuban people, without it being diverted by the government. They will partner with trusted third-party validators such as the Catholic Church. They can actually deliver this assistance through their local

parishes, where they know the people, they know who needs it, and they can deliver that assistance where it's not going to be taken by the regime.

Is AMERICA IN DANGER? PERRY STONE REVEALS ...

Could America be approaching a prophetic turning point unlike anything the nation has witnessed before? Prophecy teacher Perry Stone says a startling encounter led him to examine an ancient pattern surrounding Jerusalem—and what he believes it could mean for the United States beginning in 2028.

Perry was awakened at exactly 1:45 a.m. on Feb. 1 and heard an audible voice declare four years: “2028 to 2032.” He says the Lord then directed his attention to the four-year period preceding Jerusalem’s destruction by the Romans.

Could the patterns that preceded Jerusalem’s devastation reappear in America? Jesus foretold Jerusalem’s destruction in Matthew 23 and 24, and Stone notes that the catastrophe unfolded through a process culminating in A.D. 70. He believes that the four-year progression contains a prophetic pattern America cannot afford to ignore.

“Jerusalem’s events that occurred during those four years are going to repeat in patterns in the United States of America in a four-year period of time,” Stone says.

Throughout his teaching, Stone lays out connections he sees between ancient Israel and America—from the journey to their respective lands to their governmental structures, geography, capitals and biblical influences woven into American history.

But Stone’s argument becomes much more sobering when he moves from history to spirituality.

He points to idolatry, the shedding of innocent blood and sexual immorality as sins that plagued ancient Israel before judgment. Stone sees unmistakable parallels with America’s spiritual condition today.

Then come the harbingers. Citing the writings of ancient historian Josephus, Stone recounts strange signs reported around Jerusalem before its destruction: a comet, an object resembling a sword in the heavens, extraordinary phenomena in the clouds, a mysterious light at the temple, and a massive temple gate reportedly opening without human assistance.

Stone says the signs were interpreted differently, even though some believed the supernatural occurrence at the gate meant angels were protecting Jerusalem. Others believed precisely the opposite: that God’s protection had departed.

That distinction lies at the heart of Stone’s warning. America has experienced extraordinary blessing, but biblical history repeatedly demonstrates that blessing should never be mistaken for unconditional protection. A nation can possess enormous influence, wealth and strength while simultaneously experiencing profound spiritual decline.

If Stone’s 2028-2032 timeline proves significant, the most important question may not be what happens during those four years.

It may be whether America spiritually prepares before they arrive.

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
